



## Hauptwerk compatibility with Mac OS X 10.6 'Snow Leopard'

Hauptwerk is supported on OS X 10.6 'Snow Leopard' with the same [requirements](#) that are listed for OS X 10.5.6 'Leopard'. We have tested our recommended Mac interfaces with OS X 10.6 which perform well with the following exceptions at the time of writing:

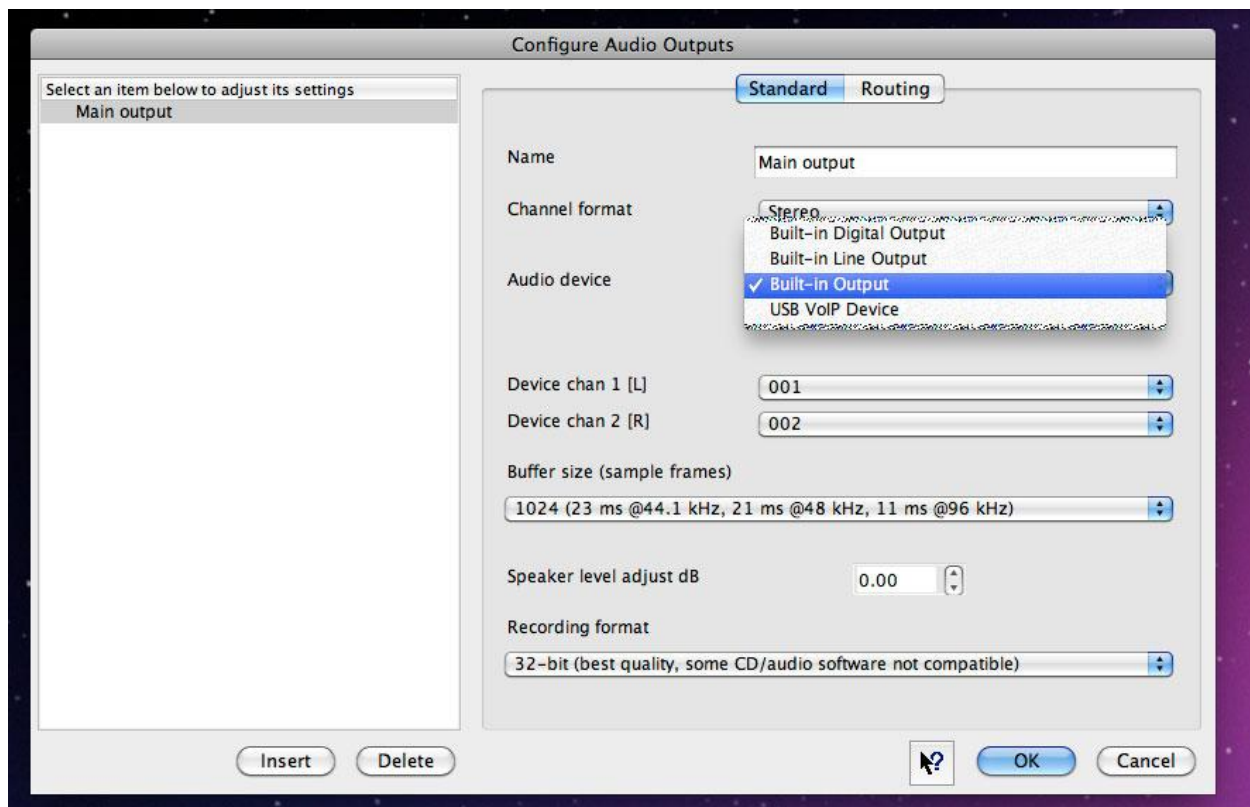
- M-Audio audio devices may not work until new drivers are released by them. The MIDI Sport 4x4 works with OS X 10.5.8 drivers on Snow Leopard.
- MOTU 24 i/o has issues with multiple units not showing all available channels when daisy chained.

Performance on OS X 10.6 is at least as good as it was on OS X 10.5 and in most cases improved. If you are considering upgrading to Snow Leopard please note the above issues and check with the manufacturers websites prior to upgrading to search for new drivers which may or may not be available.

### HAUPTWERK COMPATIBILITY ISSUES FOUND:

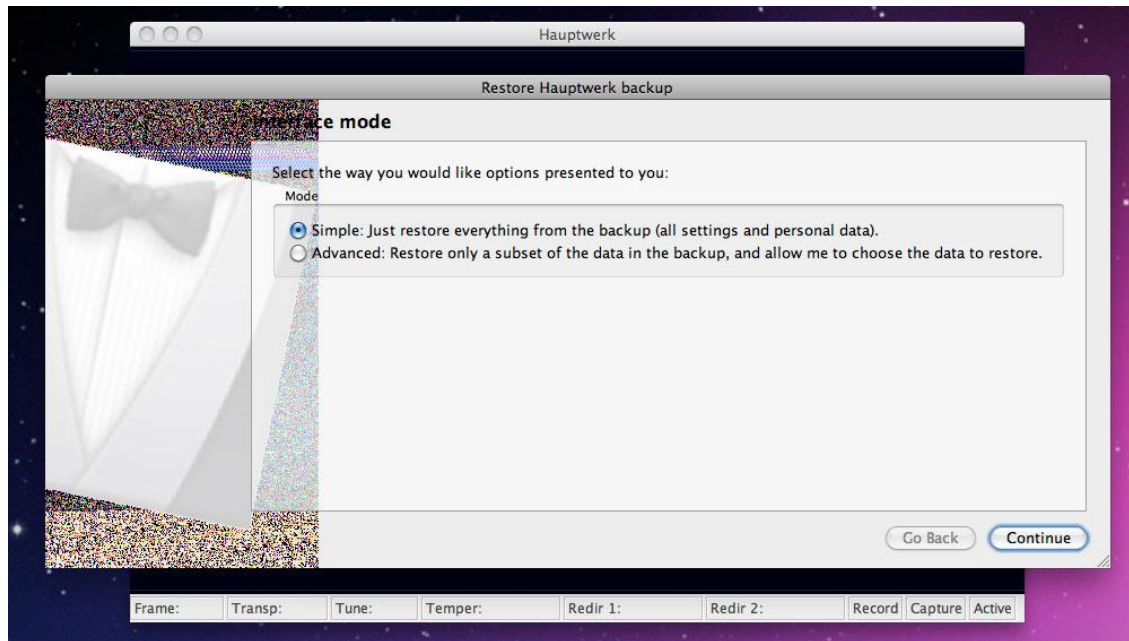
#### 32-bit Hauptwerk

- Drop-down lists (combo boxes) sometimes show a dotted multi-colored interference around them.





- Wizard screens also have a color interference pattern down left-hand side.



## 64-bit Hauptwerk

- 'File | Create backup ...' and 'File | Create diagnostic file ...' not working properly: save-as dialogs give incorrect message about invalid file extension (because Hauptwerk's file extensions contain multiple '.' characters). Clicking any of the options leads to an incorrect file extension on the resulting file. Work-around: use 32-bit Hauptwerk to create backups or diagnostic files.
